Position description

The *Ecological Oceanography Lab* in the Red Sea Research Center at King Abdullah University of Science and Technology (KAUST) is seeking a Postdoctoral Researcher to lead projects investigating coral nutritional ecology at multiple spatial and biological scales. The researcher will work closely with Michael Fox (PI), the coral restoration team at KAUST's Reefscape Restoration Initiative (KRRI), and an interdisciplinary team to unravel species-specific nutritional needs and optimize feeding programs for coral nursery applications. The researcher will conduct fieldwork and tank-based experiments in the Northern Red Sea in collaboration with KRRI. The position is initially for one year and renewable for up to two. Compensation includes relocation costs, global health insurance, and subsidized housing at KAUST. Salary is commensurate with experience. Anticipated start date: February 1, 2024.

- Leading and maintaining experimental feeding trials
- Conducting fieldwork to evaluate coral nutrition at an ecosystem scale.
- Laboratory work including biochemistry and metabolomics.
- Lead data analysis and manuscript publication
